

Federal aid regulations and laws require institutions to establish a Cost of Attendance (COA) for each student receiving any kind of financial aid or student support. The COA is derived from direct costs such as tuition and fees, and indirect costs such as housing, personal miscellaneous expenses, and transportation costs. Sample Budgets representing the average costs for the 2023/2024 academic year are below.
